The application will be considered by the Strategic Planning Committee on Monday 20 October 2025, when a decision will be made.


The next meeting is due to take place at the beginning of October 2025.

# HOUSING MANAGEMENT MATTERS: DECANTING UPDATE

We are aiming for construction works to start in Spring 2026 and are continuing to work with residents from the blocks listed below with their relocation. We understand that this can be a difficult and stressful time, and we want to thank you for your patience and cooperation throughout this process.

1-23 Curry Rise, 2-24 Curry Rise, 49-71 Bray Road & 21-47 Bray Road

Almost all residents from the affected blocks have been relocated to alternative accommodation.

### 25-47 Curry Rise

There are several households who will need to move out from this block this year. Ralph will be working with these residents to offer suitable homes and help them relocate.

#### **Homeowners**

We have arranged for Censeo financial to provide advice on future home ownership options. Resident homeowners will be sent a letter outlining who to contact and what information Censeo will need.
