At the last RSG meetings, the group assessed and selected their preferred Landscape Consultant from a shortlist. The group selected HTA who subsequently attended the March consultation event to gather your views and priorities for the future external landscape designs.

Some members of the RSG visited Grahame Park and provided feedback on the rented show flats they saw.

At the next meeting, your RSG will be reviewing the summary of the landlord offer document, which will then be shared with you at the next consultation event.
